Gen 22:16–18. “By myself I have sworn,' says the Lord, 'because you have done this and have not withheld your son, your only son, I will indeed bless you, and I will multiply your descendants as the stars of heaven and as the sand which is on the seashore. And your descendants shall possess the gate of their enemies, and by your descendants shall all of the nations bless themselves, because you have obeyed my voice.”

Gen 18:19 "I have chosen Abraham, that he may charge his children and his household after him to keep the way of the Lord by doing righteousness and justice, so that the Lord may bring to Abraham what he has promised him."

Ez 36:27 "And I will put My Spirit within you, and cause you to walk in My Statutes, and ye shall keep My Judgments, and do them".

Acts 5:29, 32 "Then Peter and the other apostles answered and said, We ought to obey God rather than men... And we are His witnesses of these things; and so is also the Holy Ghost, Who God has given to them that obey Him".

V6-7 “Surely in a flood of great waters, they shall not reach him (that is, the godly). You are my hiding place; you preserve me from trouble; you surround me with songs of deliverance.”

V8-9 “I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you with my eye upon you. Be not like a horse or a mule, without understanding, which must be curbed with bit and bridle, or it will not stay near you.”



V3-4 “For when I kept silent, my bones wasted away through my groaning all day long. For day and night your hand was heavy upon me; my strength was dried up as by the heat of summer.”



V10-11 “Many are the sorrows of the wicked, but steadfast love surrounds the one who trusts in the Lord. Be glad in the Lord, and rejoice, O righteous, and shout for joy, all you upright in heart”!
