Rom 6:15-18 “What then? Are we to sin because we are not under law but under grace? By no means! 16 Do you not know that if you present yourselves to anyone as obedient slaves, you are slaves of the one whom you obey, either of sin, which leads to death, or of obedience, which leads to righteousness? 17 But thanks be to God, that you who were once slaves of sin have become obedient from the heart to the standard of teaching to which you were committed, 18 and, having been set free from sin, have become slaves of righteousness.

1 John 3:9 “No one born of God makes a practice of sinning, for God's seed abides in him, and he cannot keep on sinning because he has been born of God.”

Matt. 6:24 “No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and wealth.”

Matt 7:13-14 There are two and only two gates: the narrow gate that leads to life and the broad gate that leads to destruction.

Matt. 7:17-19 There are two and only two types of trees: the good tree that bears good fruit and the bad tree that bears bad fruit.

Matt. 7:24-27 There are two and only two kinds of builders who build two and only two kinds of houses: Wise builders build on the rock; foolish builders build on the sand.

Lk 6:46 “Why do you call me Lord, Lord and don't do what I say”?

1 John 5:3-4 “For this is *what* the love of God *looks like*, that we keep his commandments. And his commandments are not burdensome.”

1 John 2:3-5 “and by this we know that we have come to know him, if we keep his commandments. Whoever says “I know him” but does not keep his commandments is a liar, and the truth is not in him.”

Matt 10:34-39 “Do not think that I have come to bring peace to the earth. I have not come to bring peace, but a sword. For I have come to set a man against his father, and a daughter against her mother, and a daughter-in-law against her mother-in-law. And a person's enemies will be those of his own household. Whoever loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me, and whoever loves son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me. And whoever does not take his cross and follow me is not worthy of me.”

Their response **V33** “We are Abraham’s descendants and have never yet been enslaved to anyone; how is it that You say, You will become free?”

John 8:34 “everyone who abides in sin is a slave to sin.”
