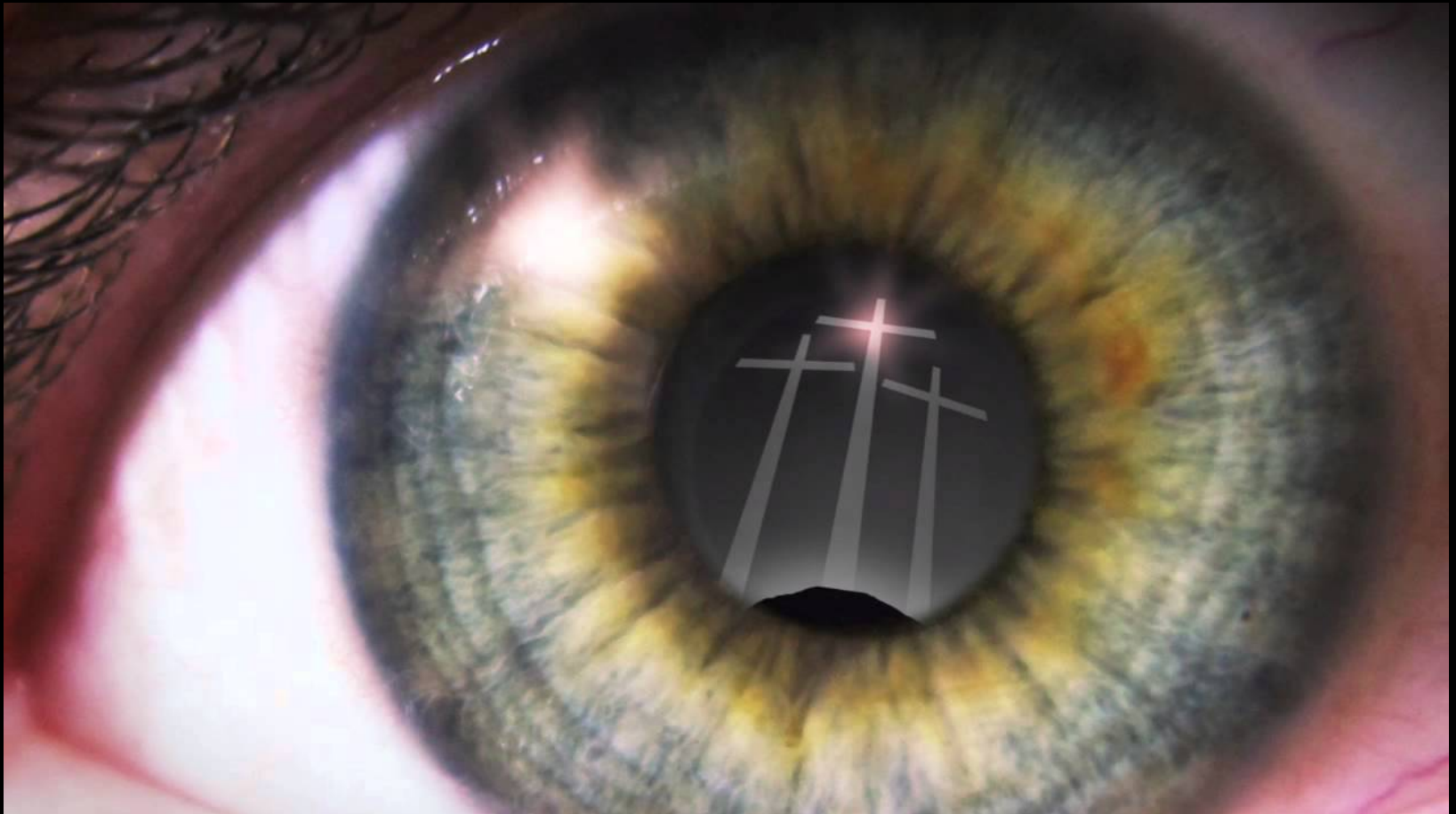


Spiritual Sight

2 Cor 4:3-4

Ps 73:1 “Truly God is good to Israel, to those who are pure in heart.”

Ps 73:2-3 “But as for me, my feet had almost stumbled, my steps had nearly slipped. For I was envious of the arrogant when I saw the prosperity of the wicked.”

Ps 73:4-5 “For they have no pangs until death; their bodies are fat and sleek. They are not in trouble as others are; they are not stricken like the rest of mankind.”

Ps 73:6-9 “Therefore pride is their necklace; violence covers them as a garment. Their eyes swell out through fatness; their hearts overflow with follies. They scoff and speak with malice; loftily they threaten oppression. They set their mouths against the heavens, and their tongue struts through the earth.”

Ps 73:12 “Behold, these are the wicked; always at ease, they increase in riches.”

Ps 73:13-14 “All in vain have I kept my heart clean and washed my hands in innocence. For all the day long I have been stricken and rebuked every morning.”

Ps 73:15-16 “If I had said, “I will speak thus,” I would have betrayed the generation of your children. But when I thought how to understand this, it seemed to me a wearisome task,”

Ps 73:17 “until I went into the sanctuary of God; then I discerned their end.”

Ps 73:18-20 “Truly you set them in slippery places; you make them fall to ruin. How they are destroyed in a moment, swept away utterly by terrors! Like a dream when one awakes, O Lord, when you rouse yourself, you despise them as phantoms.”

Ps 73:21-22 “When my soul was embittered, when I was pricked in heart, I was brutish and ignorant; I was like a beast toward you.”

Ps 73:23-24 “Nevertheless, I am continually with you; you hold my right hand. You guide me with your counsel, and afterward you will receive me to glory.”

Ps 73:25-26 “Whom have I in heaven but you? And there is nothing on earth that I desire besides you. My flesh and my heart may fail, but God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever.”



Ps 73:27 “For behold, those who are far from you shall perish; you put an end to everyone who is unfaithful to you.”

Ps 73:28 “But for me it is good to be near God; I have made the Lord God my refuge, that I may tell of all your works.”

Ps 19:8 “the precepts of the Lord are right, rejoicing the heart; the commandment of the Lord is pure, enlightening the eyes”

Ps 119:103 “How sweet are your words to my taste, sweeter than honey to my mouth!”
